Day 1 -London

Day 9 – Glasgow to Belfast via Giant Causeway

Leave for Port of Cairnryan and the ferry to Northern Ireland (included, approx 3 Hours)

Leave for the amazing **Giant Causeway** passing Carrick Castle and Carrick-a-rede rope bridge for photostops, the return journey past quaint Irish towns and film locations for the game of Thrones TV series

Overnight stay in Belfast

Day 10 - Belfast to Galway

Early orientation tour of Belfast, inc The Big Fish Sculpture, Stormont assembly, St Anne's cathedral Then all aboard for the trip to the County of Galway, Galway is known far and wide for its culture, picturesque landscapes, street buskers and medieval heritage and signature ceol agus craic
